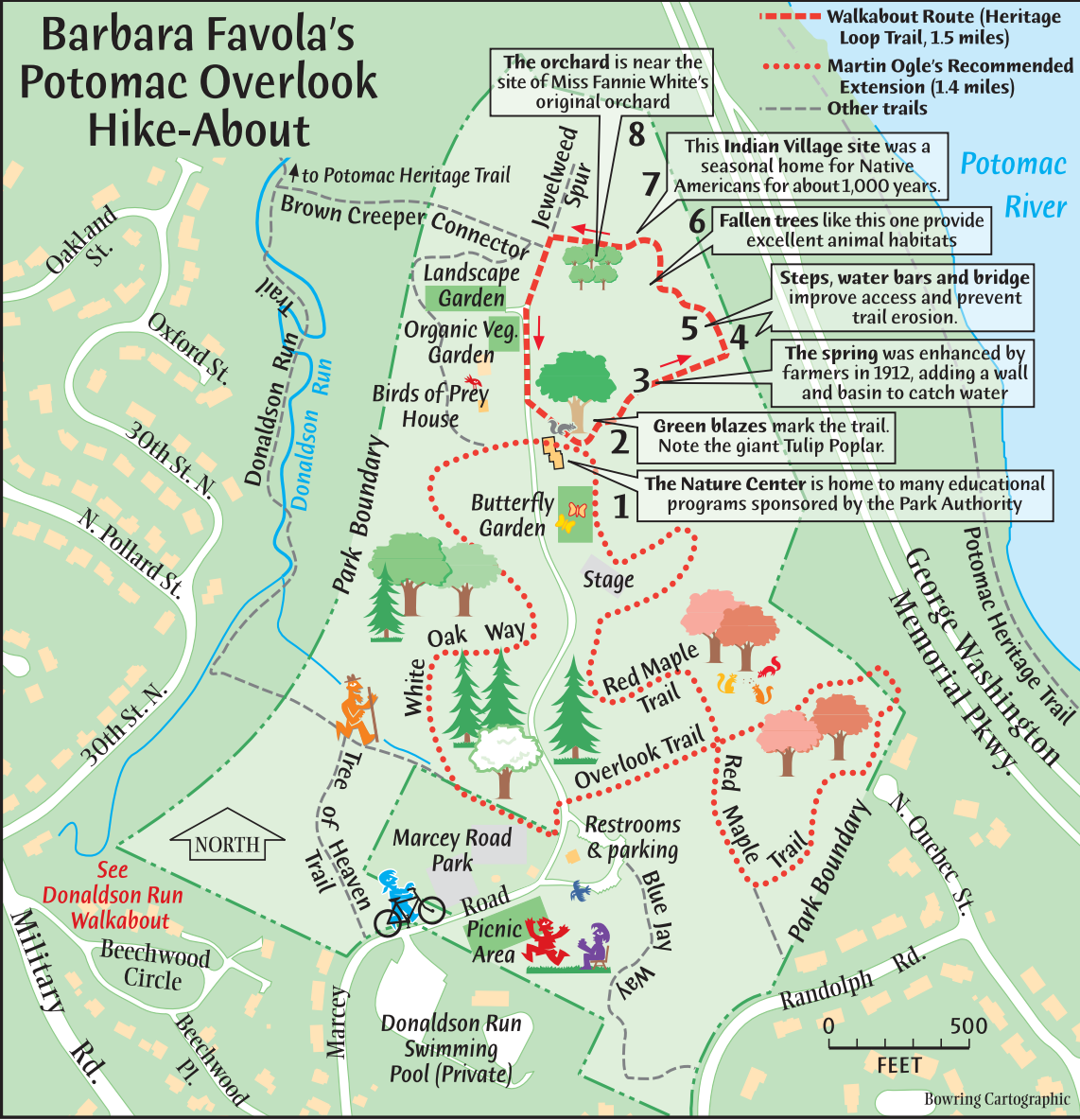




WALKArlington Walkabouts: Potomac Overlook



Length:
1.5 miles with optional 1.4 mile extension (or alternate route)

Terrain:
Unpaved, undulating.

Ambience:
Absent the occasional jet flyover, a peaceful and educational haven for walkers.



Located on the Potomac Palisades, this Northern Virginia Regional Park offers 70 acres of peaceful woodland connecting via the Donaldson Run Trail to more extensive foot paths along the river. The twining trails that traverse the park offer glimpses into the history of humankind — most notably, Indians and farmers — on the site. The Nature Center offers outdoor adventure programs and environmental education year-round, while a lively mix of performances fills the amphitheatre with music during warmer months.
