

DOMINION HILLS

First settled by Native American tribes, then English colonists in the 1600s, this area remained largely rural from the Civil War to the early 1900s. Then Merwin “John” Mace bought land here in 1945, named it Dominion Hills, and built more than 400 homes by 1951. Today this arrowhead-shaped west Arlington neighborhood remains mostly residential with plenty of multimodal connections to commercial areas and transit options.
