

GEORGE WASHINGTON'S FOREST

George Washington purchased this 1,200-acre tract of land in 1775. Spanning multiple Arlington neighborhoods (Glencarlyn, Forest Glen, Arlington Mill, Barcroft, Douglas Park, Columbia Forest, and Claremont), a small portion of the original property has been preserved as parkland, with plentiful connections to trails, sharrow, roadways, and bus routes.
